REVISED REQUIREMENTS AND EVALUATION CRITERIA FOR REGISTRATION OF INTEGRATORS.

The National Transport and Safety Authority (NTSA) is a state corporation established under the National Transport and Safety Authority Act Number 33 of 2012 whose objective is to harmonize the operations of the key road transport departments and help in effectively managing the road transport sub-sector and minimizing loss of lives.

In the fulfilment of the above mandate there is need for exchange of information between the Authority and Insurance Companies in a structured and secure manner.

To this end the Authority seeks to identify insurance access integrator(s) - who are defined as an entity or entities with software or an application that can remotely access the Authority's data or information and transmit in electronic format to a group of insurance companies and vice versa to simply management of data integration.

From this integration, it is expected that the integrator shall provide a secure platform that will enable insurance companies send their motor vehicle insurance policies, information on accident and salvage vehicles to the Authority's system – Transport Integrated Management System (TIMS)- in real time while at the same time provide insurance companies with a way of validating vehicle ownership.

In order to ensure to minimize multiple and individual integrations between the Authority and Insurance Companies, it is proposed that the integration be done through an integrator or integrators.

All applicants are required to submit the following information together with their applications:-

2	Statutory documents	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Certificate of Incorporation. - PIN Certificate. - CR 12. - Valid tax compliance. - Business permit.
3	Performance security	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Submit a bank guarantee of ksh twenty five million shillings.
3.	Audited Accounts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Financial year 2017 and 2018
4	Regulators license	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - CAK licensed as a content service provider for 2016, 2017,2018 and 2019.
5	Technical proposal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Submit a proposal on integration and exchange of data including detailed specification on data that the Authority shall receive from the insurance companies. - Methodology and proposed approach to implementation. - Submit a provisional list of atleast 10 insurance companies interested in joining the project. - Training. (Written and oral presentation required).
6	System security	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - antivirus, antispymware, antimalware, firewalls, operating system patches.
